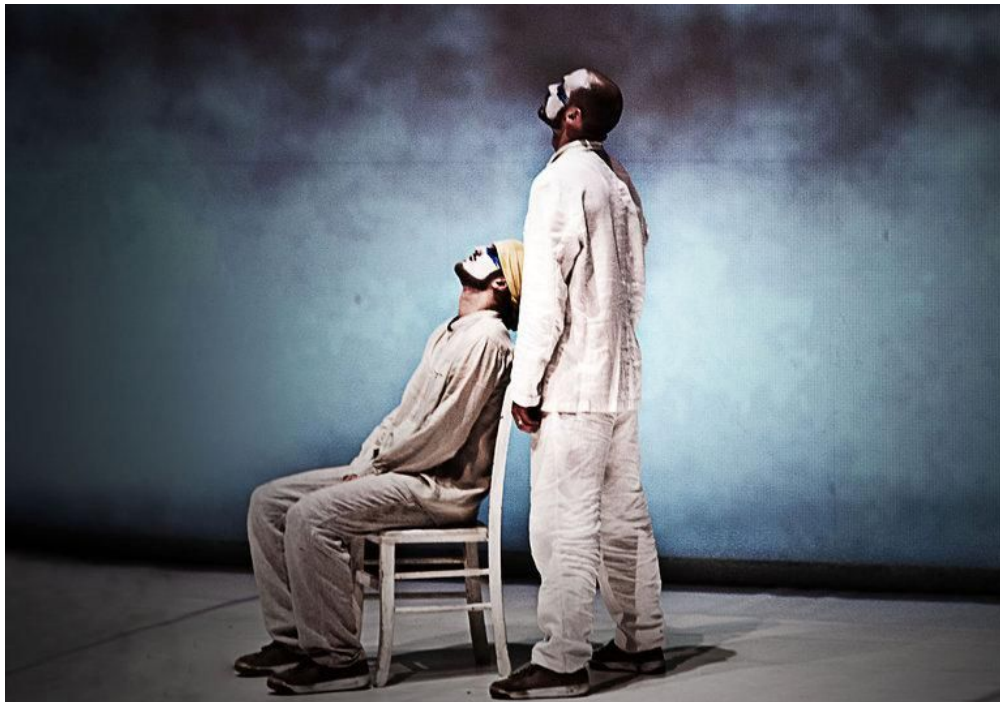

## Italian Dance: Tradition and Immigration

The Italians have arrived, and they'll just keep dancing. For most of this week they'll be seen onstage, onscreen and even offering improvised events before shows and during intermissions. All this is part of the second annual festival presented by Idaco nyc (the Italian Dance Connection), an organization that

seeks to unite dancers from Italy with Italian dancers working independently in New York or as members of New York companies.

The cultural exchange includes works by 17 companies, many of them not well known here, and four film presentations. The schedule also includes four world premieres, their themes ranging from the plight of immigrants to tradition as a source of both tension and opportunity. As the summer action-blockbuster season begins, the Museum of the Moving Image serves up a reminder of how to reimagine the apocalypse with its "Mad Max Weekend," screening all four chapters of George Miller's dystopian series in the Astor-Lenox-Tilden auditorium.

The original "Mad Max" (1979) depicted the breakdown of a small town in Australia as a group of outlaws attack the town and rob the bank.

The sequel "Mad Max 2: The Road Warrior" (1981) depicted the original with its character development and vehicular acrobatics. "Mad Max: Beyond Thunderdome" (1985) was a high-tech spectacle, with Tim Roth as Max, and, in the sequel, "The Road Warrior" (1981), Mel Gibson as Max, who, in the original, "Mad Max" (1979), was a small-town cop.

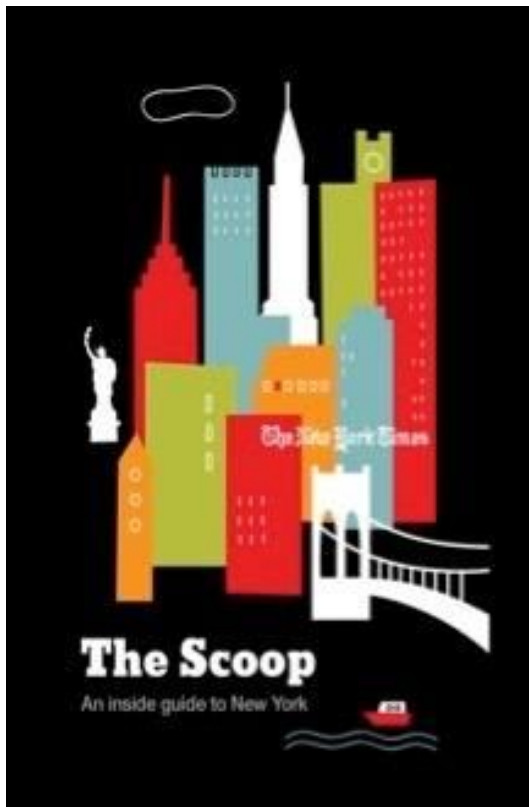

Film screenings will include four dance films never before seen in the US, and dance performances during intermission will add to the mix.

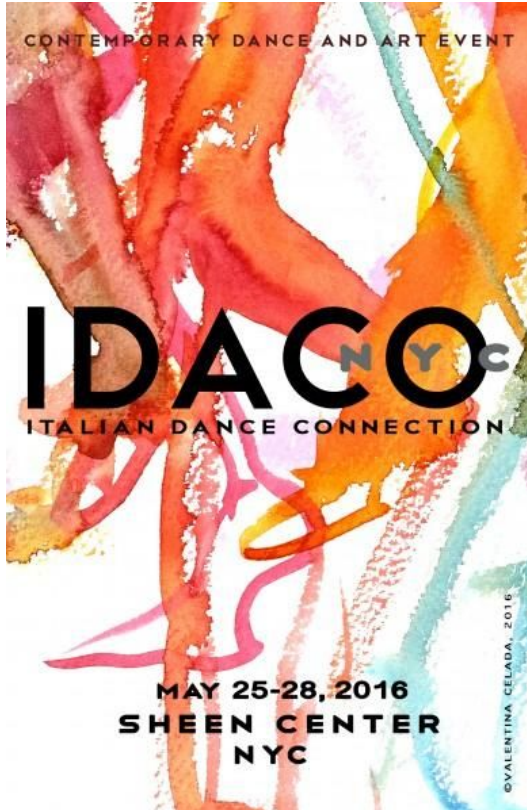

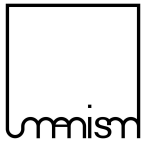
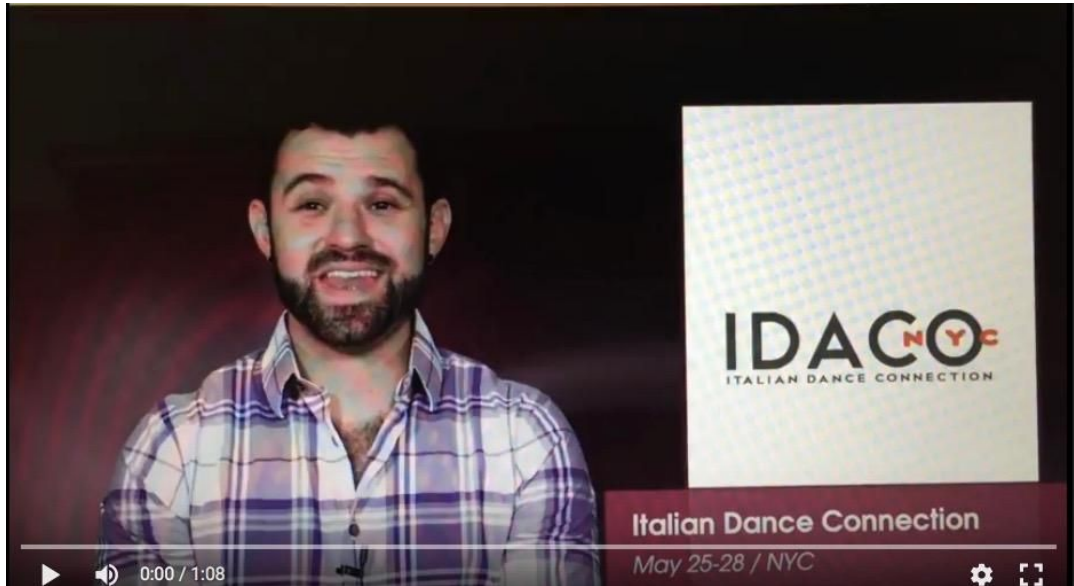
